

Hosereels and Catherine Reels

Collins Youldon has manufactured hosereels since the early 1980s and has developed a comprehensive range for various applications, including fire fighting, washing down, LPG and domestic fuel oil delivery.

Our hosereel catalogue describes in detail the models currently in production and the many optional features available to provide the equipment best suited to your requirements.

There are 5 basic models of hosereel, each with different dimensional characteristics. Within these models, each is available with varying drum widths, from 8" to a maximum of 36".

Fluid paths are available in ¾", 1" and 1¼" bore in mild steel, 1" in stainless steel, and 1½" and 2" bore in gun metal, aluminium or stainless steel. Surface finishes include polyester powder coat in several standard colours, with galvanised and stainless steel models also available.

There are several manual rewind options, from direct axial (crank) rewind through to geared and angled options.



We also offer a sloping frame which angles the rewind handle downwards (if the reel is mounted high up) or upward towards the operator (for floor mounted units).

All Collins Youldon reels are fitted with a range of safety features, including full guarding to chains and gears, clutches on electric motors, and speed reduction gears.

Hosereels are available with several power rewind options including pneumatic, electric and hydraulic.

A range of hose roller guides, brakes, inverted mounting kits, swingout frames and high pressure or twin fluid path options are also available.

Catherine Reels are designed for fuel oil delivery and include electric, pneumatic or hydraulic motor rewind. These reels are widely fitted throughout the UK on road tankers and are highly reliable and respected.
